2018 TRUE NORTH STRONG SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The True North Strong Scholarship

Northern Credit Union is providing five \$1,000 scholarships to Ontario students who make a difference in their community.

Grade 12 students in Ontario who are planning to attend a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2019 are invited to write a 1,000 word essay about one of three topics related to their community and their education. Points will be given for identifying key concepts, as well as creative writing. Five scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded.

Eligibility

To enter and be eligible to win, you must be a legal resident of Canada (Ontario), enrolled as a full-time Grade 12 student in a Canadian high school for the entire Competition Period and attending a post-secondary institution in the fall of 2019.

You're not eligible to participate if you're an employee, representative or board member of Northern Credit Union, their affiliates, licensees, promotion partners, advertising and promotional agencies, or a member of the households (whether related or not) of those employees. You must submit your application by April 30th, 2019.
